



200 Club Rules

Purpose

The purpose of the 200 Club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the SCNA 200 Club account and used to meet funding requests from the association primarily to support local campaigning activities.

Rules

1. For a cost of £25 per year you will be allocated one number between 1 and 200.
2. A draw will be made every month, with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
3. The prizes will total 50% of the annual income.
4. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize, 2nd prize & 3rd prize for 10 out of 12 months. The prizes for Summer and Christmas Draws will be higher.
5. The 200 Club is a private lottery and is open to all paid-up members of South Norfolk Conservative Association. Anyone aged 16 or over can join.
6. Numbers are limited to 10 per member
7. Payments must be made by annual standing order or annual cheque.
8. Members' numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
9. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be resold.
10. The draw shall be made monthly by an officer of the association or the 200 Club Administrator
11. The winning cheque(s) will be posted to the address on your membership application or prize money will be transferred to your bank account within two weeks of the draw.
12. The name and numbers for each month's winners published via the members ebulletin unless the winner chooses to remain anonymous.
13. The 200 Club is run by South Norfolk Conservative Association. In case of any dispute the decision of the 200 Club Administrators is final.
14. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 200 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
15. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into SNCA funds after six months.
